Dear Year 13 families,

We are writing with confirmation of plans for the end of your child's time at St Paul's Way Trust Sixth Form.

Thursday 29th April - Friday 14th May

The internal written assessment window will start on Thursday 29th April and run until Friday 14th May. During this time all lessons will take place remotely and will consist of 50 minutes of guided revision with your child's teachers, followed by 50 minutes of independent study. If your child has an exam in the afternoon, they will not be expected to attend their period 3 and 4 lessons. Attendance in lessons is compulsory until the exam(s) in that subject are complete.

Monday 17th May - Friday 28th May

In order to complete the practical element of their assessments, science students should continue to attend the normal timetabled science lessons (in person) from Monday 17th May Friday 28th May unless otherwise communicated by their subject teachers. Except for those who study Biology, Chemistry or Physics, students will not be expected to attend academic lessons after Friday 14th May.

In order to support your child's post-18 transition, we will be facilitating a number of in-person workshops designed to equip your child with the additional knowledge and skills they will need to successfully navigate the world as an adult. The sessions, which are compulsory for all Year 13 students to attend, have been carefully planned to cover important material under the headings of "Healthy Relationships" (appropriate use of the internet, consent and coercive behaviours) and "Independent Living" (consumer rights, housing and workplace contracts).

These sessions will take place in the Willoughby theatre at the following times:

Tuesday 18th May, 1.50pm	Healthy Relationships	Tuesday 25th May, 1.50pm	Independent Living
Thursday 20th May, 1.50pm	Healthy Relationships	Thursday 27th May, 11.00am	Independent Living

Students are reminded that, whilst on the school premise, they should adhere to the school dress code and should maintain the high standards of behaviour as set by the school.

In addition to the above in-person sessions, we will also be hosting an online workshop with Queen Mary University on Wednesday 26th May at 2.00pm to raise your awareness of what to expect from results day. This session will take place via the google classroom.

Monday 31st Onwards

We are in the process of planning a whole cohort enrichment activity and celebration event to recognise your child's hard work throughout their time in the sixth form. Exact details of this are being finalised and will be shared with you in due course.

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It is important to note that the Teacher Assessed Grading window will end in late June. The school, therefore, may be in touch for additional assessment related queries until June 18th. Please do make sure your child is contactable up until this date.

We wish your child all the best for the upcoming assessment window - they have shown great fortitude throughout their time at the Sixth Form and we look forward to seeing them evidence all their hard work throughout the next two weeks.
