Dear Year 12 Parent/Carer,

I write to inform you that yesterday we received confirmation that a student in Year 12 has tested positive for COVID-19.

In line with guidance for Secondary Schools, close contacts have been identified and those affected have been asked to isolate for the required period. The School always places the health and safety of the whole school community at the forefront of its plans. The school has been fully prepared for this situation and is following advice from Public Health Protection Team officials; they have confirmed there is no further action to take in this case.

I wanted to reassure you that despite several students in the year isolating, we will continue to deliver high-quality lessons to your children to minimise the impact this has on their studies. Non-isolating students will continue to attend their lessons in person. Students who are isolating will participate in their timetabled lessons remotely by logging into their google classrooms at the start of each lesson. Attendance is being monitored and the usual follow up calls are taking place if a student is not in class.

If your son/daughter is isolating, we appreciate your support in ensuring that they are logged into their lessons at the correct times as seen below.

Lesson 1 – 9.00am - 10.35am

Lesson 2 - 11am - 12.40pm

Tutor time - 1.15pm - 1.40pm

Lesson 3 - 1.40pm - 3.30pm

Please be assured that, fortunately, we were able to complete the End of Year exams in person. These papers are currently being marked by the teachers. You will receive a transcript with your son/daughter's score and grade for their exams before the school closes for summer. COVID permitting, we look forward to welcoming you into school in September to meet with teachers and discuss your son/daughter's progress.
