Year 12

Year 12 Parents Evening is fast approaching and will be taking place on Thursday 23rd February. All parents/carers should have received letters home with log in information to access school cloud, our virtual parents' evening platform. Through this you can book video appointments with your child's subject teachers. We encourage you to utilise your child's data sheet (which was sent home before the half term) to inform your conversations with their subject teachers. This will help support them with their end of year UCAS predicted grade exams in July (dates tbc).

Work Experience

All year 12 students will take part in a one day out of a three, day virtual work experience series taking place from Tuesday 28th February to 2nd March. This will be led by our careers manager Ms Kawtar and an external organisation, The Switch. The three days will be industry themed and include workplace tasks, a group project and a Q&A session with business professionals. It is compulsory for students to attend, and the sessions will take place on the school site. These plans will be unaffected by the planned national teacher strike action on the 2nd March.

Year 13

Mock Exams

All year 13 students will sit their final set of mock exams from Monday 6th March - Monday 20th March; the full timetable is accessible on the school website. These plans will be unaffected by the upcoming national teacher strikes on 14th and 15th March. It is imperative that students attend all exams and treat them with the upmost importance as they will be a clear indicator as to what they are likely to achieve in their public summer exams. Student their public summer exam timetables before half term so please liaise with them regarding this exam window. Please help us to support your child by ensuring they are completing their homework and independent revision at home. All year 13 students are working on creating a revision timetable during tutor time, this should help them to manage their time.
