Careers Education and Guidance

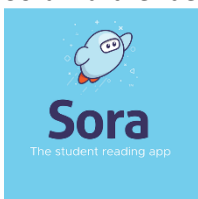

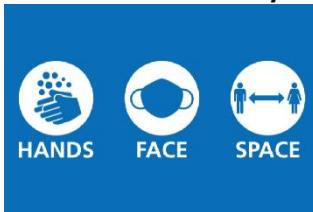

With the ongoing Coronavirus pandemic, the school library will remain closed for the foreseeable future. Students can still borrow library books by using Reading Cloud to reserve a book, or by visiting the library trolley which will be in their playground at lunchtimes. Year 7 can access the trolley on Mondays, Year 8 on Tuesdays, Year 9 on Wednesdays, and Years 10-13 can come to the library desk to speak to Ms Farley or Ms Sandra about borrowing books. The library trolley contains a wide selection of texts selected specifically for each year group. Book loans are for the duration of two weeks following which students must either return or renew their library book. The library also runs numerous competitions throughout the school year including Get Caught Reading, national competitions, and competitions associated with World Book Day. We hope your family remains well during the holiday period. If, however, a positive test is confirmed, please follow the guidance detailed below on reporting this to the school:

- *For the first 6 days after teaching ends, if a pupil tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school, the school will assist in identifying close contacts and advising self-isolation, as the individual may have been infectious whilst in school. This will be in place until 01st April. In such cases please email confirmation of the positive test to the school admin address admin@spwt.net*
- *Where a pupil tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school, the school should not be contacted for tracing. Parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.*
- *For all positive cases, please continue to email details to the school so that this can be logged for the school's tracking purposes.*
