

Remote learning Years 7-11

Dear Parent/ Guardian,

We hope that you and your family are well. To support families with remote learning, a range of support materials will be produced over the coming weeks. Morning registration and assembly

- All students log on at 9am to register and watch the daily assembly video.
- Students who have not logged on by 9.15am will receive a reminder text to parents, and a follow-up phone call if they have not logged on that morning.

Daily lessons

- All students have three lessons per day with an accompanying video.
- Each lesson will take up to 100 minutes and students should take a 20-60 minute break from the screen after each lesson.

Equipment for lessons

- Exercise book or lined paper to write on, or type work directly on to the computer
- A blue/ back pen, ruler, and green pen

Timetable

- **Years 7-9** have a timetable which differs from their in-school timetable. The Year Team leader will specify in the daily assembly the lessons for each day.
- **Years 10-11** follow their normal timetable, which is in the student planner.

Teacher checking of work

- Teachers will check student work the day after the lesson and return it with a code.
- Students given a code 3 are expected to make improvements to their work. We encourage you to check returned work with your child and review the codes they are given.

Code	What it means
1	Above and beyond: excellent work, well done!
2	You have completed your work to the expected standard.
3	Your work is incomplete: your teacher will specify what you need to do to improve.
